Facts about Rodos weather from November to March

The island of Rodos has an ideal winter climate and holds the European sunshine record with an average of 330 sunny days per year.

The following table provides useful climatological data, based on 10 year averages, as measured by the Greek National Meteorological Organization from its station located at Diagoras airport:
